

## Scholarship Foundation to Honor Emily Bourne Grigsby at Founders Luncheon on November 5th

*Possible Woman Foundation International will Honor Grigsby at its Founder's Luncheon at the Atlanta Country Club.*

"If Superwoman really existed, Emily Bourne Grigsby would be wearing the cape," says Susan Hitchcock, Vice President and Director of Women's Initiatives, Turknett Leadership Group. "She is a bon vivant, a bold and charming feminist, an attorney/arbitrator, and a noted artist. Emily's also a former model, opera singer, interior designer, and multi-engine pilot. Perhaps the real question is this: what hasn't she done in her eight decades of life?"

On November 5, 2009, Possible Woman Foundation International will honor Mrs. Grigsby at its Founders' Luncheon at the Atlanta Country Club. PWFI is a 501(c)3 that awards academic scholarships to women in need enabling them to return to school and eventually to the workforce. Since 2001, PWFI has provided more than \$100,000 in scholarships giving women a second chance—a chance to get the education they need to fulfill their dreams.

Emily Bourne Grigsby is a true inspiration to any woman who dreams of returning to school to pursue her goals. Twenty-six years after completing an undergraduate degree in education at Mills College, Mrs. Grigsby obtained a Master of Science in City Planning from Georgia Tech. Later, at 60 years of age, Mrs. Grigsby got a law degree, passed the Georgia Bar and became an arbitrator for the National Association of Securities Directors (NASD) and a mediator for the Justice Center. Now in her eighties, Mrs. Grigsby only recently retired from her work in arbitration and mediation but continues to keep up-to-date with developments in finance, politics and current events.

Mrs. Grigsby will be recognized for her work with PWFI as an advisory board member, a charter board member and for her generous financial contributions. Also being honored at the luncheon will be the founder, Linda Wind and founding board members Dr. Marjorie Barlow, Mary Jane Bills, Denise Billups, Nancy Frenkel, Susan Hitchcock, Patricia Koehn, Barbara Rose and Dr. Betty Siegel.
